The Exhibition was opened by the Deputy Mayor, Councillor Raut, who was very impressed with all the work on show. The number of members who submitted artwork was 49 which is about the norm. We had 502 visitors with Saturday and Sunday being particularly busy. We sold 25 items totalling £1501 and greetings card sales of £229. Overall, the cost of the exhibition was £255.59 which wasn't too bad considering the sales were down on the spring and our room hire cost is still £1350 for the five days.
